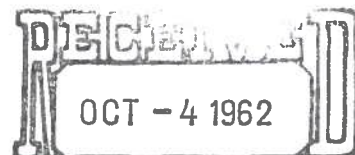

NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Heretofore, the Commission has issued various orders establishing drilling and spacing units, allowables and field rules governing the development and production of oil and gas from the "J" sand of the Adena Field, Morgan County, Colorado.

On September 21, 1962, The Pure Oil Company filed with the Commission an application requesting deletion of Rule 5 of Order No. 26-30 in Cause No. 26, Adena Field, which rule reads as follows:

"Rule 5. No oil or gas shall be produced from wells with a producing gas-oil ratio of Ten Thousand (10,000) cubic feet per barrel of oil, or greater. All produced gas shall be metered within practical limits."

Applicant believes and avers that the conditions which made the above rule necessary no longer exist, and that the Adena "J" Sand Field has attained such a state of depletion that subject rule can safely be deleted.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to said application, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on:

TIME: 10 a.m.

PLACE: Room 132, State Services Building, 1525 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
