**318A.a. and 318A.c.**


Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Rule 318A.a. designates five “drilling windows” per quarter section of land in the Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) – 400’x400’ boxes in the center of each quarter/quarter section, and an 800’x800’ box in the center of the quarter section.

Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Rule 318A.c. also states that certain well locations must be “twinned” (be located within fifty (50) feet of an existing well).




