On October 1, 1963, Monsanto Chemical Company filed with the Commission an application for an order enlarging the Little Beaver "J" Sand Field, as previously defined in Order No. 30-18, to include the following lands in Washington County, Colorado, to-wit:

Township 1 South, Range 56
West, 6th P. M.

Section 29: $W \frac{1}{2} W \frac{1}{2}$
Section 32: $W \frac{1}{2} W \frac{1}{2}$

and for an order establishing 160-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from said "J" sand formation; and, further, permitting a combination of contiguous, cornering, or adjoining drilling units into compact blocks or tracts not to exceed 640 acres, with allowables for such combined units to be produced from one gas well; and for an order establishing a maximum rate of gas production, with allocation of said allowable production among and to the aforesaid drilling and spacing units on an equitable basis.
