NOTICE OF HEARING

BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE LITTLE BEAVER FIELD, WASHINGTON AND ADAMS COUNTIES COLORADO.

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Commission issued its Order No. 30-23 on January 12, 1965, which established rules governing the production of gas from the "J" Sand formation of the Little Beaver Field. As set out in Rules 3 and 4 of said order, the method of allocation of gas among the producing properties has resulted in some inequities, and will impose a hardship on the gasoline plant if continued.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, upon its own motion, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on:

Denver, Colorado

The Commission has called this hearing to consider changing the method of allocation of gas production among the separate tracts, and adjustment of current coverage and underage of gas production, but in no event to change to more than 1,400 MCF per day the maximum allowed from the gas portion of the "J" Sand formation.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of the Little Beaver Field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
