Walsh, as duly appointed operator of the Masters Field, filed with the Commission an application for an order approving the injection of water for secondary recovery purposes into the "D" sand reservoir of the Masters Field, through the Furrow No. 1 well located 330 feet east of the west line and 980 feet south of the north line of Section 30, Township 5 North, Range 60 West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado; and for revision of the field rules governing the Masters Field.
