NOTICE OF HEARING  
BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO  
CAUSE NO. 32  
IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE BOBCAT FIELD, WASHINGTON AND MORGAN COUNTIES, COLORADO  
TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On the 6th day of May, 1954, the Commission issued Order No. 32-1, Cause No. 32, which order provided for 40-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil from the "D" sand pool underlying Sections Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), and Seventeen (17), Township One (1) South, Range Fifty-six (56) West of the 6th P.M., Washington County, Colorado; and Sections Thirty-two (32), Thirty-three (33), and Thirty-four (34), Township One (1), North, Range Fifty-six (56) West of the 6th P.M., Morgan County, Colorado, which area is referred to as the Bobcat Field.

Development of the Bobcat Field since the issuance of said Order No. 32-1 indicates that portions of the area included in Order No. 32-1, Cause No. 32, should be deleted.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, upon its own motion, has set the above entitled matter down for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

All persons interested in such a matter are invited to appear and submit recommendations to the Commission as to what areas should be deleted from Order No. 32-1 as set forth above.
