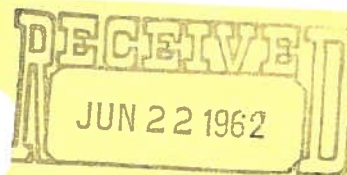

of the Adena-South Field, the Com-
mission has instituted this proceed-
ing to consider vacating all orders
heretofore issued by the Commis-
sion in this cause, and to substitute
in lieu thereof the provisions of the
general rules and regulations of the
this Commission.

All operators and owners of work-
ing interests, and all persons in-
terested in the Adena-South Field,
are hereby requested to appear at
the above-scheduled hearing and
show cause, if any they have, why
the Commission should not vacate
all orders previously issued in
Cause No. 33, Adena-South Field,
and substitute in lieu thereof the
provisions of the general rules and
regulations of this Commission.

Pursuant to said hearing in the
above entitled matter, at the time
and place aforesaid, or at any ad-
joined meeting, the Commission
will enter such orders as it deems
appropriate to prevent the waste of
oil and gas, either or both, in the
operation of said field, and to carry
out the purposes of the statute.
