

NOTICE OF HEARING TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, on its own motion, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on:

PLACE: Room 320E, State Capitol Denver, Colorado.
Because of the present depletion of the Adena-South Field, the Commission has instituted this proceeding to consider vacating all orders heretofore issued by the Commission in this cause, and to substitute in lieu thereof the provisions of the general rules and regulations of this Commission.
All operators and owners of working interests, and all persons interested in the Adena-South Field, are hereby requested to appear at the above-scheduled hearing and show cause, if any they have, why the Commission should not vacate all orders previously issued in Cause No. 33, Adena-South Field, and substitute in lieu thereof the provisions of the general rules and regulations of this Commission.
Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
