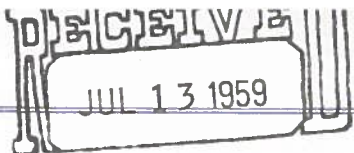

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN THE SPACING AND DENSITY OF GAS WELLS IN THE GREENWOOD GAS FIELD IN BACA COUNTY, COLORADO

CAUSE NO. 34

NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Commission has previously issued its Order No. 34-1 and 34-2, which provide, among other things, for the spacing of gas units of approximately 640 acres, and said Order No. 34-2 also provides for two units in Township 35 South, Range 41 West, described as (1) the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 10, Section 15, and E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, for an approximate 660-acre unit; and (2) the W $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, for an approximate 649-acre unit.

On July 1, 1959, the Skelly Oil Company filed with the Commission an application for an order amending the spacing provisions of said Order No. 34-2 by deleting Lot 13, containing four acres, from the unit described as the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 10, Section 15, and E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, thus decreasing the acreage of said unit from 660 acres to 656 acres; and that said Lot 13 of Section 16 be added to the unit described as the W $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, E $\frac{1}{2}$ and E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, thus increasing the acreage of this unit from 649 acres to 653 acres; and that the terms of said Order No. 34-2 remain in effect as to all other units and provisions applicable thereto; and for such other orders, rules and regulations as may be necessary in the premises.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to said application, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
