This email is to notify you that we have low top of cement on the PA 433-2 on the GV 84-1 Pad. Details of this well include:

PA 433-2 (05-045-20887) – MV Well

- This well is a new drill (spud: 3/21/2013)
- Top of Cement – 5,392'
- This well **does not** cover 200' above the top of the Mesa Verde (Geology pick: 5,168')
- This well **does** cover the top of gas (geology pick: 6,393')
- Bradenhead Pressure: 0 psi
- Top perf: 6,705'

This well is scheduled to frac this Monday, April 15th. WPX would like to request permission to move forward with completion operations of this well. Please advise if this plan is acceptable.
