I understand that including the pits on all locations has been the standard process, and usually is acceptable, but I have to review the location as if the pit will be constructed. At the Bailey location, the pit appears to encroach on a small playa. Therefore, we need to have a further discussion about mitigating that encroachment - or if the location will use water from the Hemberger pit, then a pit at the Bailey may not be required, thus avoiding filling a portion of the playa.
