NOTICE OF HEARING TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On December 18, 1989, the Commission authorized Order Nos. 112-74, 75, 76, and 77 to be issued which pooled all interests in four separate drilling and spacing units described herein below for the proper and efficient development of the methane gas contained within the Fruitland coal seams underlying said units with all interests pooled in accordance with the provisions of C.R.S. 34-60-116 (7), to with:

The Commission at its hearing on June 15, 1990 accepted the application and directed that the matter be heard at the July 16, 1990 hearing of the Commission.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene should file with the Commission a written protest or a notice to intervene no later than July 10, 1990, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or notice to intervene to the person filing the application. A fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall accompany each document filed with the Commission.
