On June 1, 2013 at 10:45 AM a completions contractor was laying down a wireline lubricator and felt a pop in his left knee. The knee was x-rayed on the day of the incident with negative results. The contractor had an MRI done on the knee on June 7, 2013 that revealed a torn meniscus. Surgery was required on the knee which was performed on June 11, 2013. The contractor was able to return to work the following day at the contractors office. Shaun Kellerby with the COGCC was notified of the injury status change by e-mail at 11:05 AM on June 12, 2013.
