Listed below are CPWs recommended BMPs for the proposed Axia Energy LLC Bulldog 22-41V-890 location.

Pad location: Bulldog 22-41V-890, T8N, R90W, section 23 at 40.644322, -107.467275
Document #: 400417464

Wildlife concerns: The proposed pad location is within greater sage-grouse Preliminary Priority Habitat, greater sage-grouse production area sensitive wildlife habitat (SWH), and mule deer critical winter range SWH. Given the proximity to Highway 13 and adjacent infrastructure, wintering mule deer and greater sage-grouse reproduction impacts are expected to be minimal. However, large numbers of big game regularly move through this area in the spring and fall, and impacts migration are CPW's greatest concern at this location. CPW recommends the following BMPs:

1. Establish company guidelines to minimize wildlife mortality from vehicle collisions on roads.
2. Include a weed management plan and implement the plan as part of reclamation.
3. Avoid aggressive non-native grasses and shrubs in mule deer habitat restoration.
4. Install and utilize bear-proof dumpsters and trash receptacles for all food-related trash on location, following COGCC Rule 1204 a-1.

CPW would appreciate your concurrence with the proposed BMP's. Form 2A comments for this location are due Sunday June23, 2013.
