In accordance with Rule 305 of the COGCC, notice is hereby given that Grand Mesa Operating Company (GMOC) plans to drill a well on your land before the end of 2013. We are enclosing herewith various forms which are required by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC).

COGCC regulations provide that the surface owner may waive the 30-day notice requirement as well as request a consultation meeting with representatives of GMOC. You may also designate a representative to attend this consultation meeting. The enclosed form should be signed and your wishes stated as to the 30-day notice, request for consultation meeting and designated representative. Please return this form to our office in the envelope provided.

We are also enclosing a Surface Damage Agreement for your signature. Please sign this form before a Notary Public and have the Notary complete the acknowledgement at the bottom of the form. This form should be returned to our office with the Waiver and Consultation Form.

Also enclosed is a copy of the COGCC's Oil and Gas Well Notification, Consultation and Reclamation Rules: Information for Oil and Gas Operators, Surface Owners and Surface Tenants. As Operator we are required to furnish this document to the surface owner.


