Dear Mr. Lepore:

Please let this letter serve as a request for the omission of open hole logs. The COGCC has acknowledged that a cement bond log will be accepted in lieu of open hole logs when sufficient nearby wells provide adequate open hole log data as long as Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. logs up to above the surface casing. All cement bond logs will be logged above the depth of the surface casing shoe to satisfy the state's request. Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. will ensure that open hole logs are run into the surface casing on the first well drilled on any vertical well pad. Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. will submit open-hole logs on every well when they are run. The Form 5 will clearly state the well that the open-hole logs were run on, or if none were run, it will be clearly stated on the Form 5.
