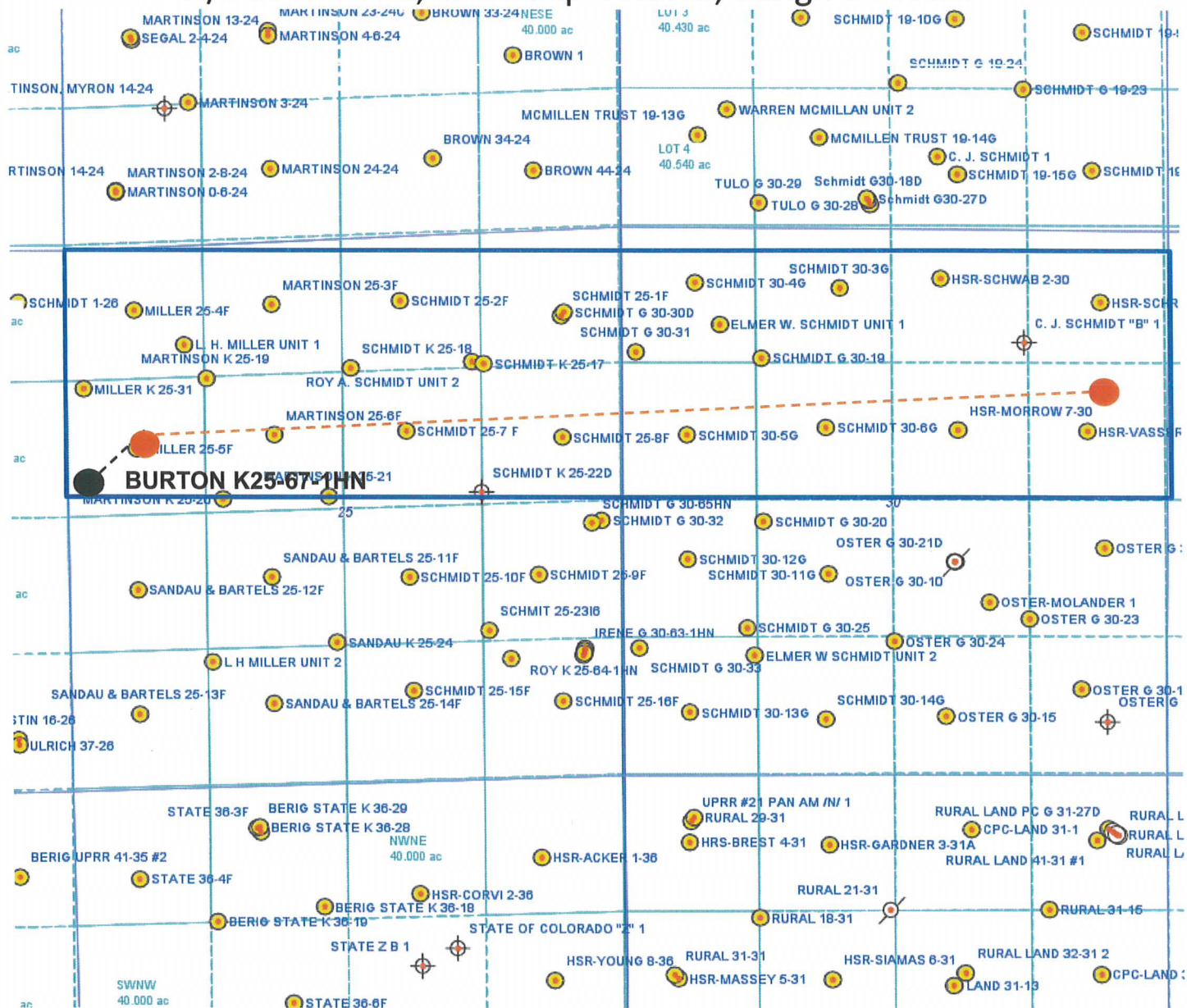

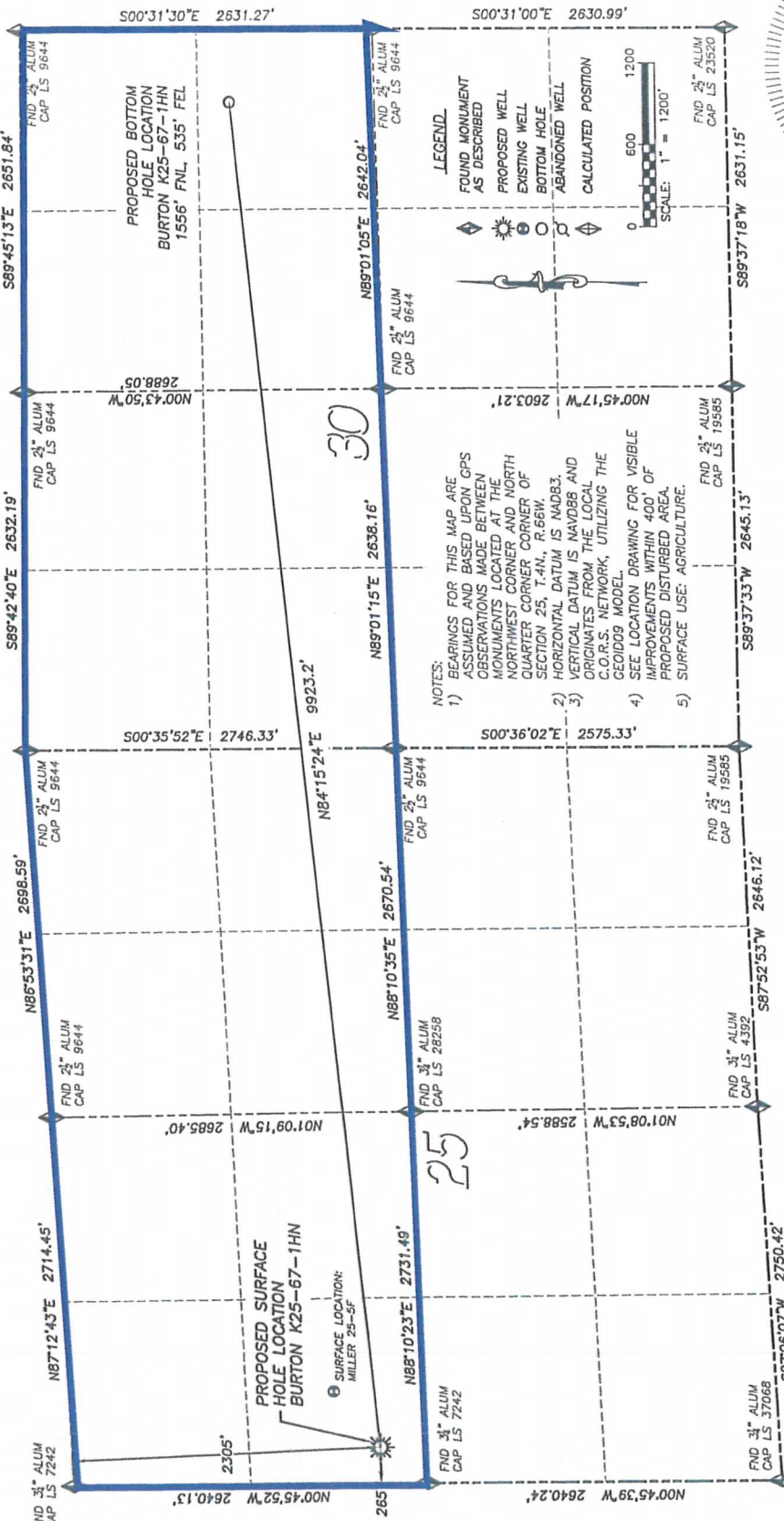
Proposed 659.67± acre spacing unit
