Dear Director,

Synergy Resources Corporation respectfully requests the Director approve an exception to Rule 318A to allow the Gilbert well(s), listed above to be drilled at the above referenced location. Rule 318A(a) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations requires the well(s) drilled in a square with sides four hundred (400) feet in length, the center of which is the center of any quarter/quarter or a square with sides eight hundred (800) feet in length, the center of which is the center of the quarter section. The well being permitted is an exception location at the request of the surface owner.
