Hi Gentlemen,

As we previously discussed in our meeting earlier this year, Antero had one final pit at the Dever A Pad which was physically closed in early 2009 but was not closed through the COGCC. Historic contamination was identified in our earlier 2013 sampling at the Dever A pad, and Antero subsequently conducted remediation activities at the site. The project was slower than we originally anticipated due to cold weather followed by wet weather, but the area has now been excavated, at the supervision of Mark Mumby at HRL, and sampling confirms compliance with Table 910 Standards (as more fully described in the attached Form 27).

I trust you will find everything in order, but if you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact me.

Carlos, I know you have moved on to greener pastures, but I thought I'd include you here since you were so involved with the entire project!
