1) Due to the proximity of surface water (279 feet), water wells (271 feet), and shallow ground water (15 feet) I will change the Sensitive Area designation from NO to YES in the Water Resources section.

2) Due to the proximity of nearby surface water to the oil and gas location, I would like to add the following Condition of Approval:
"Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect the irrigation ditch located 279 feet west of the oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products.
