Attached is the form 19 for the Blue Chip Northstar 24-1.

The site was recently P&A in May/June. After the surface equipment was removed at the site MEC Inc. inspected the trenches the areas below the former tank. The soil was brown to dark gray, discontinuous areas, with a slight odor (the odors included petroleum and decay organic odor). Field PID screening did not detect any hits and the lab samples collected were ND.

The site was backfilled at that time.

The site/area is currently being developed and the grading excavation contractor encountered the discolored soils and arranged for their environmental consultant A.G. Wassenar to inspect the site. Their sampling confirmed elevated TPH readings above 900mg/kg in one sample.

I have met with the A.G. Wassenar consultant at the site.

On behalf of Blue Chip, I am arranging to proceed with the excavation/ remediation of the impacts. If everything falls into place we may be able to start the excavation activities this Thursday, Sept 5. Hopefully no later than early next week.

If you would like the memo I prepared for the June site inspection and the site diagram for the samples obtained by AG Wassenar, I can forward them to you. Otherwise I was planning to include the info with the Form 27 submittal.
