The above referenced lands ("Subject Lands") are subject to Order No. 407-795 and 535-361 which established a 640 acre drilling and spacing unit for the Subject Lands, and allowed for eight(8) horizontal wells to be drilled for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, with the treated interval of the horizontal wellbore to be no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 250 feet from the treated interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.

Bill Barrett Corporation ("BBC") intends to drill and complete the Kunsemiller 5-61-21-0108BH horizontal well on the Subject Lands. The well would be drilled so that the "treated interval" (i.e. perforated and fracture-stimulated portion) of the horizontal lateral is 178' from the Pronghorn #31-21 well located in the NW¼NE¼ of Section 21, Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M. Weld County, Colorado, which is operated by Bonanza Creek Energy Operating Company LLC ("BCEO").

BBC has obtained permission, contained in a waiver, from BCEO.

Thank you for your attention to the enclosed. BBC respectfully requests that the COGCC review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location waiver and application for permit to drill the captioned well.
