
Quicksilver Resources Inc. (QRI) requests approval of our Form 2 without consultation per Rule 303.I (1) and (2) for the referenced well. The Pirtlaw 32-09 was spud on 02/24/13, drilled to 5,215', set intermediate casing, and rig was released 03/20/13 due to wildlife restrictions. QRI planned to move back on the well this fall and drill a vertical well to 8,100' TVD.

QRI recently completed the remaining portion of an existing lateral in Moffat County and based on the encouraging results, we now believe it will require horizontal wells to make this play economic. This well has wildlife and lease stipulations that warrant immediate drilling operations and in addition, a rig has just become available that is capable of drilling the horizontal section.

Waivers from the Routt County LGD and the surface owner are attached for your review.

The purpose of this letter is to request that you grant Quicksilver Resources Inc. Quicksilver planned on moving back on the well this fall and drilling a vertical well but due to economic, geological, and maximization of production reasons we have now determined that a horizontal well is needed. A rig capable of drilling this horizontal section has just become available allowing use to meet our geologic target. 
