Ladies/Gentlemen:

Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP ("KMG") respectfully requests the Director approve an exception to Rule 305.a.(2) to allow the submittal of a Form 2A Oil and Gas Location Assessment to the Director for the above mentioned wells. Rule 305.a.(2) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations requires notice to be sent to the Surface Owner and Building Unit Owners within the Exception Zone or Buffer Zone no less than thirty (30) days prior to submitting a Form 2A Oil and Gas Location Assessment to the Director. The building unit owner within the Buffer Zone has agreed in writing to waive the 30 day notice referenced in Rule 305.a.(2) for the above-named wells.

Please be advised that pursuant to this rule; Kerr-McGee Oil and Gas Onshore, LP ("KMG"), as the proposed operator of the above referenced well(s) and/or facilities), intends to file a Form 2A on the above captioned well(s) no less than thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. The tentative date operations will commence will be (2<sup>ND</sup> quarter 2014).


