The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) has specific guidelines and procedures regarding surface activities. These rules stipulate an operator must give an affected surface owner notice in writing at least thirty (30) days prior to drilling an oil and gas well.

It is Anschutz Exploration Corp. intention to begin operations to drill an oil and gas well on the lands described above. Operator may drill the well thirty (30) days from this date or sooner if your approvals to waive the thirty day notice requirement is given below. It is your responsibility to notify the tenant farmer, if applicable, of this proposed operation.
