



**Geologist Information**

General: Existing location, 8 new wells (5 existing wells)  
 Ownership: Fed Surface, Fed Minerals  
 SUA Status: N/A  
 Spacing Units: N/2 320 acre unit

**Plan of Development**

**Access:** Existing access will be modified near the PA 44 -27 and DOE 2-W-27 to reduce existing road grades.  
**Drilling:** Efficiency Rig  
**Cuttings:** Cuttings managed on surface on the northern most cut slope of the pad.  
**SIMOPS:** Yes  
**Completions:** Completions will frac from the remote frac pad - PA 11-35 frac pad (Puckett surface) and 3-4.5" surface frac lines will be run from frac pad to DOE 2-W-27 pad. A water supply line will be run from the PA 11 -35 frac pad along existing roads/pipeline corridors to a tie-in near the main road.  
**Flowback:** To PA 11-35 Frac Pad  
**Production:** Production equipment to be place on the south west corner of the pad. Condensate and water to be piped to the proposed East Parachute Tank Farm (Exxon surface) tank pad.  
**Pipeline:** A new 8" gas/4" produced water line/1-2" condensate lines are needed. We also have plans to instal up to a 6" injection line for future injection.
