Brad,

Based on review of the information provided in the Remediation #4301 Status Report dated October 31, 2013, COGCC concurs with the request to end land treatment of oily waste at the subject location. The sampling and analysis has demonstrated that the material is now in compliance with applicable Table 910-1 standards; as a result, the material can be used on site to backfill the remaining pit and Caerus Washco LLC (Caerus) shall proceed with final surface reclamation.

The associated Pit Facility ID #117560 was changed to closed status in the Colorado Oil & Gas Information System. Remediation Project 4301 will remain open until final surface reclamation is completed in accordance with COGCC Rule 1004. Caerus shall perform appropriate surface reclamation of the entire land treatment and former pit complex area no later than May 31, 2014. Caerus shall maintain stormwater controls and perform weed control to comply with the Colorado Noxious Weed act until the location has been reclaimed. When the location complies with Rule 1004 requirements, notify COGCC via Sundry Notice Form 4 that reclamation is complete and request a final inspection with a reference to Remediation #4301.

The associated Form 4 is being processed and will be approved after it is entered into the eForm system.
