I just received a call from a landowner who lives near one of our wells.

Ann Arens bottles her tap water to drink and has recently noticed bubbles in the water. She said she thinks it tastes like methane. She saw some work being done at a nearby well and thought it might be related (she mentioned it was electrical work being done). Their water is normally very good quality, and the well is 140-150 ft deep.

BP's Emmett Wolter Gas Unit 1 well is approximately 500 feet south of her home (API 0670714100). We currently have truck traffic near the location as we are prepping to do some pipeline work.
