COGCC has reviewed the Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan for the Antelope K-O-31HNB submitted by Bonanza Creek Energy, Inc. on December 5, 2013. Based on the information presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the closure request. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.
