Dear Mr. Deranleau and Mr. Andrews,

I am writing to inform the COGCC of Synergy Resources Corporation's mitigation practices and plans for the development of the Gilbert (aka: On the Green) drilling project within the above captioned location.

Synergy is concurrently working with the City of Greeley through a Use by Special Review process and the following is a bullet-point of items Synergy will do to minimize the impact during the drilling and completion process and also during the production phase.

- 1- A thirty foot sound and light temporary mitigation wall will be installed around the entire location.
- 2- We will utilize the existing fire hydrants for all of our water needs during the drilling and completion of these wells- thus reducing truck traffic by eighty percent.
- 3- We will utilize the nearby electric capacity and purchase electric for our compression and vapor recovery equipment- thus cutting down on noise and emissions.
- 4- We will require our third party completions contractor to utilize the Sierra equipped sand movers to contain all Silicate sand on location during the completion process.
- 5- We will utilize Ensign Rig 131, an Automated Top Drive, Natural Gas Rig that will considerably cut down on noise and emissions during drilling.
- 6- We will access from 35th Ave to West 24th Street to the location. We have met with School District 6 Representatives, as this access goes past the South Entrance to Greeley West High School. The School District Reps blessed this access with some requests to avoid the high traffic times of day during drop off and pick up of Students. This route is the only practical route as the intersection of Centerplace Drive and 35th Ave has a drastic dip that will not allow trucks to cross this intersection. The City of Greeley also knows of this issue and has blessed this route to the location.
- 7- We will schedule a neighborhood meeting to visit with all directly affected residents. This is a requirement of the City of Greeley also.
- 8- We will fully berm and landscape the location to the requirements of the City of Greeley for the production phase of the development of these minerals. (See attached)
Please note- the attached shows the equipment to serve 16 wells – we are only requesting permits for nine wells on this location.
