Subject: Grizzly 3-32H BMPs

Hi Doug,

We've reviewed the materials for the Grizzly 3-32H location. No timing restrictions necessary on this one, given the current disturbance and distance from the highway. I've also dropped any reclamation and traffic related BMPs due to the current condition of the site and location. Just checking to see if we're in agreement on these standard BMPs?

1. Use hospital grade mufflers for compressors, pump jacks, or other motors necessary to run operations at the site. Mufflers will be pointed upward to dissipate potential vibration.
2. Install and utilize bear-proof dumpsters and trash receptacles for all food-related trash on location, following COGCC Rule 1204 a-1.
