Provide a detailed description of the accident, problem, and cause (equipment failure, human error, etc.):

Damage to a workover rig and snubbing unit was incurred on Saturday, January 25, 2014 when pipe released from the snubbing unit at the Bella Federal 15N-7HZ well. 2 minor injuries that did not require first aid or medical treatment were associated. Snubbing activities were underway, with approximately 850' of production tubing in the well. All pipe was released from the well and the BOP was engaged. An investigation is underway. Probable contributing factors include human error and equipment failure. The workover rig is owned and operated by Bayou Well Services and the snubbing unit is owned and operated by Great White Pressure Control.
