It is stated in the plan that a temporary secondary containment earthen berm will be constructed around the filter box which will contain 110 % of the fluid volume of the GeoTube. Per Rule 605.e., Ursa Operating Company LLC (Ursa) shall place a synthetic or engineered liner shall be placed directly beneath the filter box(s) coming along the sides of the earthen berms. 605.e. Buried or partially buried tanks, vessels, or structures. Buried or partially buried tanks, vessels, or structures used for storage of E&P waste shall be properly designed, constructed, installed, and operated in a manner to contain materials safely. A synthetic or engineered liner shall be placed directly beneath. Such vessels shall be tested for leaks after installation and maintained, repaired, or replaced to prevent spills or releases of E&P waste.
