Thursday 12/12/2013 one of our separator units overheated and "boiled" off about 90 gallons of Anti-Freeze onto the ground.

The area is roughly 15'x16' in size. Does this fall under the auspices for reporting to the COGCC?

I'm trying to figure out the correct forms and notifications for reporting.

Regardless how I need to report, we intend to clean up the mess as recommended on the MSDS for the Anti-Freeze.
