Ladies/Gentlemen:

Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP ("KMG") respectfully requests the Director to approve an exception to Rule 317.o and only run an LWD gamma ray log in the horizontal section in the above stated wells on the same well pad. Rule 317.o of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations requires wells to be logged with a minimum of a resistivity log with gamma ray. The above-named wells are requested to be exempt from this requirement due to the proximity of existing well(s) with acceptable resistivity logs with gamma ray. The available log(s) are within 660 feet of the vertical section(s) of the proposed well(s).

The proposed wells will be logged with an LWD gamma ray log in the horizontal section. The wells will also be cased-hole logged with a cement bond and gamma ray log from the production casing shoe to the surface. The Drilling Completion Report (Form 5) submitted for each well will indicate that no open-hole logs were run.

The existing well(s) within 660 feet with acceptable resistivity logs with gamma ray are listed in the table below:
