Cynthia,

Because this freshwater pit will actually be the existing pit located on the Hemberger 26-34-8-60 location (Location ID #425541) approximately 1,100 feet west, I will remove the BMPs that mention the freshwater pit on this Form 2A.

Also during my review, it appears the nearest Public Road is approximately 4,545 feet north (Hwy 14) as shown on your Location Drawing. Therefore I will change that distance in the Cultural Distance section of the Form 2A.
