My name is Mark Stonehocker, I am manager of Brighton Farm LLC. Brighton Farm owns surface and minerals in sections 7 and 8 1S67W in Adams County. Attached is a file containing 4 separate form 18 complaints and associated pictures of environmental issues on our property. Based on these complaints I have two requests that I would like your help with. First, I would like to request that the COGCC take soil samples at these locations to determine if the soil / water is contaminated and to what level. I believe that the oil leaking on the surface of the ground for several years is from the oil coolers on these old pump jacks, and the saturation could run very deep. My second request would be to schedule a meeting with you to discuss older, unresolved, complaints I filed regarding contamination of unlined de-watering pits and flow line leaks.
