- All wellheads have been tested to 120% of working pressure;
- All pipelines have integrity per the 1100 series rules;
- All trash and debris have been removed from the site, to the greatest extent possible, and the facility or well will operate safely per Rule 603.f.;
- All known flood -related spills and releases have been reported per Rule 906.b. and all necessary remediation has been reported per Rule 906.d.;
- All related utility infrastructure have been re-established in a manner consistent with the safe operation of the facility or well.
