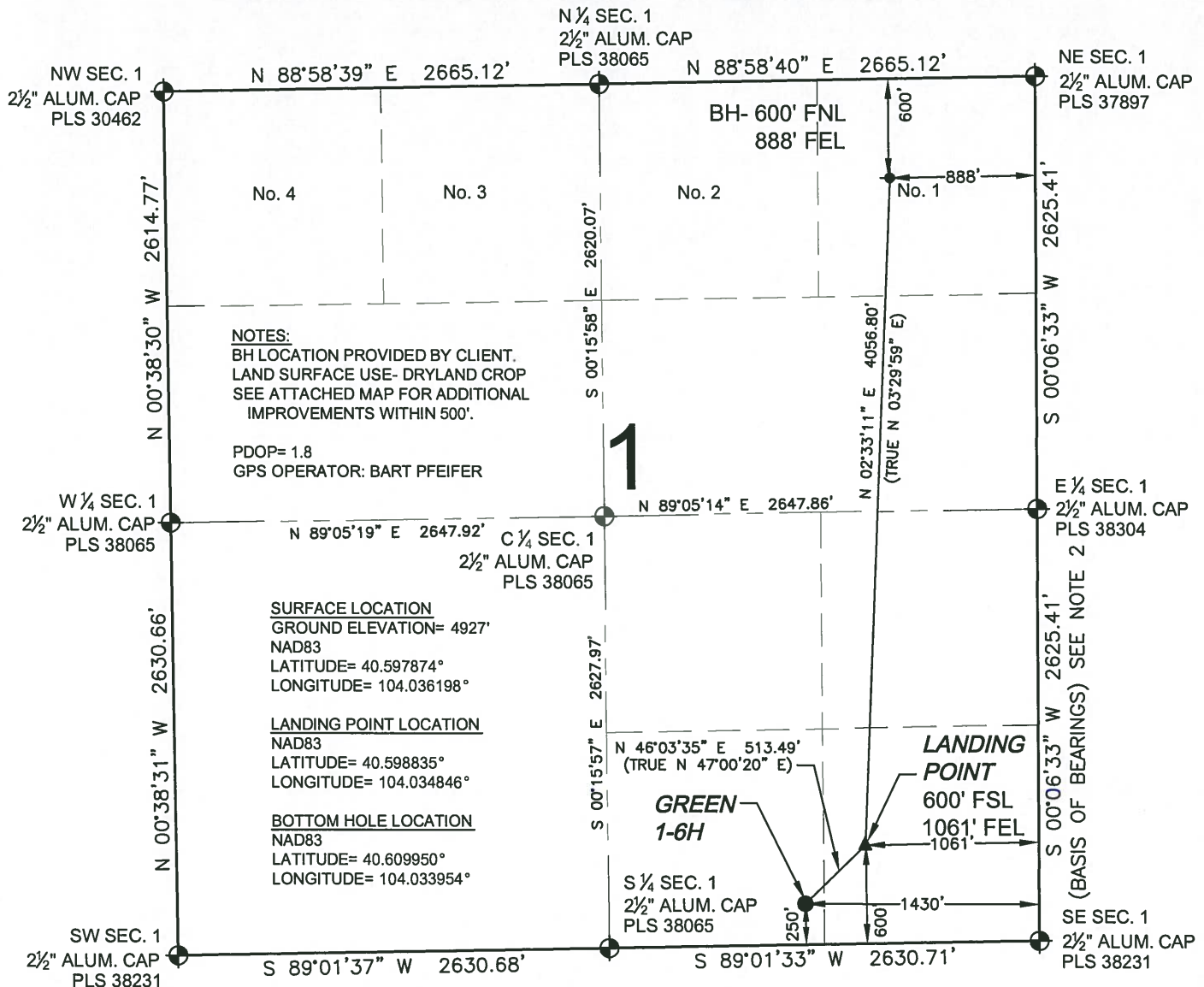


# WELL LOCATION CERTIFICATE: GREEN 1-6H

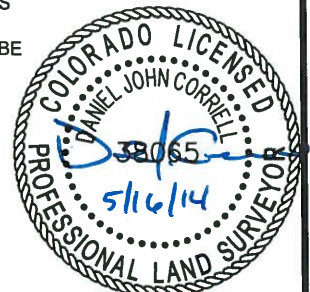
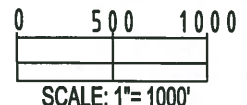
- = EXISTING MONUMENT    ♦ = BOTTOM HOLE
