Angie,

I have completed my review of the above referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

- 1) You have indicated there will be a Freshwater Storage Pit on this oil and gas location; therefore, I will add it to the Facilities list.
- 2) Your pipeline description is incomplete given that you have proposed numerous wells, tanks, separators, compressors, and flares for this oil and gas location. Please provide a description (number, size, material, buried or not, pressurized or not) for all oil, gas, and/or water pipelines on this oil and gas location.
- 3) During my review it appears that this oil and gas location is only within the 44-Olney fine sandy loam NRCS Soil Map Unit. Therefore, I will remove the additional listing of the 45-Olney fine sandy loam NRCS Soil Map Unit from the Soil section.
- 4) During my review it appears that the nearest downgradient surface water feature is greater than a mile from this oil and gas location. Therefore, I will change that distance to 5,280 feet in the Water Resources section.
- 5) During my review it appears the nearest existing water well is greater than a mile from this oil and gas location. The permit for the water well you identified as 2,600 feet from the oil and gas location indicates it has been abandoned. Therefore, I will change the distance to 5,280 feet in the Water Resources section.
- 6) Your Location Pictures do not appear to be for the Green 1-1H oil and gas location. This location has an existing well and production facilities on it, yet your Location Pictures (dated 4/15/14) only shows crop land with no existing oil and gas facilities. Please provide me with the correct Location Pictures.
