Arthur,

Sorry about that.

The GPS locations were just outside of the 0.5 mile radius, but the actual well location is just within the 0.5 mile radius. This water well (Receipt No. 9089897, Permit No. 4347--) was sampled by LTE for Nighthawk on 6/27/2012 as COGA Voluntary Baseline Sampling Protocol and was submitted to the COGCC Database on 1/21/2014 as Facility ID No. 753094. However, I would like to make sure that the results do not get uploaded as it was prior to the rule change (COGCC Form 2 submitted on 7/12/2012) and we had a different access agreement with the landowner at the time which did not specify COGCC upload approval. If that sample is in your database I would appreciate it if it was not appended.

Drilling is going to start mid next week and I will send another agreement to the landowner specifying COGCC database upload approval and try to get the sample early next week. Will this be an issue given that we do have a voluntary sample already taken?
