CAUSE: FAILURE EQUIPMENT

CAUSE INFORMATION: Presumed equipment failure of an underground dump line between the processing center and the oil tank resulted in release of very approximately 5 barrels of crude oil to sandy soil that contains vegetation. This release is in the Centennial State Wildlife Area. There is no way any crude oil could have been released from the tank through the broken pipe. The South Platte River is several hundred yards away, and downhill.
