Bryan Paraspolo oversaw the removal and stockpile of the remaining impacted soils at the site and collected composite samples under the supervision and direction of Susan Sherman of the COGCC. I received the sample results this afternoon, and the samples are in compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 values. Ryan Warner of Magpie will be conducting the loading and transporting the impacted soil to a waste disposal facility.
