




Plan of Development

 Cuttings: On surface in cuttings management area as shown.
 SIMOPS: Yes
 Completions: Remote frac from Riley frac pad. Water supplied via existing infrastructure. Run 3-4.5" frac lines from Riley frac pad to drill pad along existing pipe and road ROW, then x-country near pad as shown. On Riley frac pad.
 Flowback:
 Production: Expand separator area by 60' to accommodate additional separators. Existing 45'x45' tank area is adequate
 Pipeline: Existing gas and water infrastructure is adequate.
