Extraction Oil & Gas is planning to drill the following 5 horizontal wells as follows:

Waag #1 Well-14' FNL 1762' FWL Sec. 19 7N-65W 6th P.M.
Waag #2 Well-26' FNL 1787' FWL Sec. 19 7N-65W 6th P.M.
Waag #3 Well-39' FNL 1811' FWL Sec. 19 7N-65W 6th P.M.
Waag #4 Well-51' FNL 1836' FWL Sec. 19 7N-65W 6th P.M.
Waag #5 Well-64' FNL 1861' FWL Sec. 19 7N-65W 6th P.M.

The surface locations of Extraction's proposed wells have been staked outside of the COGCC Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window and are being permitted as exception locations. In addition, under the COGCC Rule 318A.c. any new Twinning well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. Extraction's proposed wells are located greater than fifty feet from the nearest Oil & Gas well. Extraction has obtained written permission from the surface owner by way of signed waivers. Extraction respectfully requests the COGCC to review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location waiver and Application for Permit to Drill for the wells on the subject pad.
