COGCC has reviewed the Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan for the Antelope K-O-31HNB location submitted by Bonanza Creek Energy Operating Company LLC. Based on the information presented, the spilled fluids were contained within lined containment and there was no contact with soil. Therefore, no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the closure request. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.

Remediation Project #8666 has been assigned to this release. The Spill report #2147717 and Remediation Project #8666 have been changed to resolved status in the Colorado Oil & Gas Information System. A copy of the signed Form 27 is attached for your records.

Attached is a Form 27/No Further Action request for the subject site. The site is located in the NWNW Sec 31 T5N R62W, 6PM. The release (Spill #2147717) was reported via Form 19 on February 13, 2014. Following remedial actions at the site, BCEOC has confirmed the released oil was completely removed and pumped to

the production tank. All impacted gravel was removed and hauled to a licensed disposal facility. As a result, Bonanza Creek requests a No Further Action determination for this release.
