Friday (10-31-2014) at approximately 8:00 a leak occurred on a 3" coated spool on the injection line from Emerald 17 (40.10888,-108.9168). Approximately 2.5 BBLs of produced water was released. The lateral valve was shut in immediately upon detection. Vacuum truck recovered an estimated 2 BBLs. All of the fluids were contained in the RWSU field. No impact to surface water. The affected area has been water washed and soil samples will be taken.
