Rule 204 - Denial of the Right to Inspect

> Thank you for the contact information. Yes, for your safety, you need to know that people put locks on their gates for a reason. If you trespass on their property, they have been told by the sheriff that they have the right to defend themselves and their property if they feel threatened in any way. Therefore, you need to contact us or the landowner prior to ignoring a locked gate.

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> By the way, Dennis told me a little while ago that he gave you the option of waiting for him to get back to town to escort you onto my place or to wait until I returned today. He said you were the one who chose to wait til today. I did not have your phone number until I got into the office after checking my wells this morning. By that time, as you advised me on the phone, you had already issued a violation notice. Then you hung up on me when I tried to let you know why it was so important for you to contact me prior to entering my property.

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> I am available Monday morning from 8:00 until 10:00 should you wish to inspect the Katie Eileen wells. Please let me know what time you can be at my front gate and I will escort you to the wells. Should you suspect us of criminal activity, by all means, get a search warrant and have the sheriff escort you onto our place before then. We will not shoot at him or anybody he is escorting. If your purpose is truly to inspect the locations for adherence to COGCC rules and regulations then bring your note pad on Monday and you can write up all the deficiencies you find and we will address them to the best of our ability as soon as we can. If your intention is to run roughshod over our Constitutional rights then you should be prepared for a fight because I will defend my rights and my family to the death! Any questions?
