I've had Xcel out and they've checked everything, including radio interference, and it is not their equipment that is the problem. They said it was subterranean. We've also had 2 handymen go through the house top to bottom, and there is no mechanical source for this inside the house, and they also say it is external and underground. The noise and vibration intensify at night. It's really difficult to sleep. The driveway is cracking from the vibration, and there are a couple of wall cracks forming. The noise and vibration sound like a car motor running and never stops. I did not know who to contact until I saw the 7 News article about the Encana site at Vista Ridge causing the exact same type of issue. I do know there is a well on the south side of Erie Parkway to the west of us that says it runs up into Weld County, but I don't know which site is actually the one causing this. Can you help please?</p>
