This letter is in response to the COGCC Warning Letter emailed to Cirque Resources LP, attention Robert Willis and Bill Lloyd, dated Sunday, January 25, 2015. The COGCC Warning addresses the 3 wells listed below. Our Compliance Plan is simply that Cirque will provide future timely reports and the requested reports to be submitted by January 30, 2015. The following update addresses the COGCC Warning Letter by well.

Railay 28-3-1CH well: (05-123-39863) Prior to January 30th Cirque has submitted Form 5, (with digital logs) Form 5A and the FracFocus report. Form 7 Operator's Monthly Report of Operations correcting for August shall be submitted immediately. A Sundry requesting permission to flare gas with a gas analysis attached is submitted. As noted on the Sundry the well produces very marginal gas volumes.

Lazy D ZN #03-09: (05-123-31832) the vertical "Observation" well shall have the MIT completed February 5th, we submitted Form 42 for this work. The well has always been an Observation well for horizontal completions within section 3.

Lazy D #03-15HZ: (05-123-31810) we shall file Form 42 as soon as we have a schedule for interim reclamation and contact Gary Helgeland for inspection. We are reviewing this well which we may bring back into production.

Should the reports submitted and this letter not be sufficient addressing the Warning Letter let us know immediately and especially which issues we are not addressing.

On behalf of Cirque Resources LP I truly apologize for this reporting oversight.
